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Lavender Water

Lavender Water is 100% non alcoholic water collected at the end of the steam distillation process of the Lavender, sometimes referred to as 'hydrosol.' It contains a small amount of the essential oil as well as water soluble fractions from the plant, giving it the same fragrance and properties as the lavender oil with the additional benefits of water soluble fractions of the plant. These give lavender water a unique benefit as a mild antiseptic and skin hydrator and toner.

Here are just a few uses for Lavender Water

Skin Tonic : Lavender Water's refreshing and nourishing properties make it ideal to apply after exposure to the sun. It can also be used to tone the skin following your regular skin cleansing regime.

Air Freshener : Lavender Water in a spray bottle can be used to freshen up any area of your home.

Linen Spray : Lavender Water sprayed lightly on your linen as you iron helps remove any creases and leaves the linen with the delicate fragrance of lavender.

Water Softener/Rinse Aid : Pour 1 to 2 Tablespoons of lavender water in to your washing machine where you would usually put your commercial fabric softener. During the machine's washing process the lavender water will act as a water softener and a very mild and gentle antiseptic. Your clean washing will smell slightly of lavender and when dry there will just a delicate hint of lavender fragrance.
